

Willy Wonka Performance Instructions

- Performances are at 7 pm on Thursday and Friday.
- Students need to arrive at school no later than 6 pm to get into costume and makeup. Please try to arrive by 5:45 to make this process less hectic. If you are a lead, you will need to be here at 5:45 for sound check. Please check below to see how to wear your hair for the performance.
- On Friday, we will try to take a group photo once everybody is in costume. Please make sure your child is here on time. This photo will be posted on the website for you to download and print as you would like.
- We will have a cast party on Wednesday, May 21st from 11am - noon in Greer. I will need parent volunteers to help with the party starting at 10 am. If you are willing to help in any way, please email and let me know.

How do I wear my hair for the performance?

Candy Kids: Girls with longer hair should have it in a pony tail away from your face. If you have a colorful bow, please wear it. If you don't we will have ribbon.

Oompa Loompas and Squirrels: All girls need to have their hair in a medium to low pony tail.

Augustus: Hair should be in a tight bun on lower part of head if possible.

Mrs. Gloop: 2 pony tails low on sides of head

Veruca : curls if possible...if not, a pony tail up high

Mrs. Salt: Sophisticated looking, curls are great...see me for questions

Violet: half pulled back with a white bow (if you don't have a white bow, let me know and I will get one)

Mrs. Teavee and Mrs. Beauregard: Neatly combed or barrette pulling sides back

Phineous: A tight bun (chignon) or twistvery professional looking
