

SCHOOL UNIFORM
(Updated July 2006)

The School believes that a uniform serves to create order, to make the campus more secure, to reduce clothing costs for parents, and to alleviate inappropriate social pressure.

Uniform regulations have to be enforced if there is to be integrity to the uniform policy. When students are on campus, **all** teachers are asked to enforce the policy in and out of their classrooms, but it cannot be emphasized enough that uniforms are also a matter of **parental responsibility**. Parents are respectfully asked to help by:

- Purchasing only regulation apparel
- Maintaining an adequate supply of laundered uniforms and ensuring that faded uniforms are replaced
- Refraining from allowing students to tailor uniforms in any way that changes the uniform appearance
- Supporting discipline that is imposed by teachers and administrators

All regulation uniform items must be purchased at **School Time** on Jefferson Highway in Baton Rouge. The regulation uniform items are described on the following chart:

Comments: Shoes are optional in color and style, but sandals, cowboy boots, or Birkenstocks should NOT be worn.

Senior Class Dress Code

1. Dress slacks, khakis acceptable, no jeans. For girls, a skirt or dress, appropriate length.
2. Dress or polo shirt with a collar. For girls, a blouse. T-shirts are not acceptable.
3. Dress shoes only.
4. Blazer, sweater, or vest as an outer layer.

Comments: This is an option for seniors. The senior dress code is intended as a "dress up" code. If you are in doubt about a garment's appropriateness, don't wear it.
